ORDINANCE NO. 2023-14

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL ORGANIZERS OF ANY SPORTS TOURNAMENT OR PUBLIC EVENTS HELD WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PAVIA TO PROVIDE STANDBY EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES (EMS).

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility and duty of all Local Government Units to promote and secure the health of the public including their safety as mandated by the General Welfare Clause or Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991, to wit "...*Within their respective territorial jurisdiction, Local Government Units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety... and preserve the comfort and convenience of the inhabitants*";

WHEREAS, it has been a customary practice within the Municipality of Pavia, Iloilo that during summer or at any other sports tournaments and events, organizers and their sponsors host sports tournaments and events, and, therefore, the Local

Government Unit of Pavia, Iloilo have the duty and responsibility to regulate their undertakings to protect the health of the participants who join or spectate such competitions or events;

WHEREAS, the death and disability of several athletes brought about by these tournaments across the country served as a wake—up call to local officials to avoid the loss of other young and valuable talents in the country; with the end view of protecting the general welfare and taking important steps and measures to ensure that the same incident would not happen again.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan, in a session assembled that:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the "Emergency Medical Services for Sports / Public Events Ordinance".

SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS. The following terms shall mean and be construed as follows:

AMBULANCE — is a vehicle for transportation, whether privately—owned or not, of ill or injured people from the venue of the sports tournament to the hospital or place of treatment for an illness or injury. In all sports tournaments and public events, the ambulance must be on standby at the OPCEN and shall be requested as needed.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES TEAM - pertains to the trained medical/emergency response team who provides pre-hospital emergency care.

ORGANIZER/S — a person or group of persons who organize and promote any sports tournament or public events as defined above whether for profit or not;

PLAYER/S — a person or group of persons who are bonafide residents of the Municipality of Pavia and/or were invited and had participated in any sports tournament as defined above, regardless if he or she is registered prior to the game.

SPORTS TOURNAMENT — any game, league, division, conference or friendly competition, where players exert physical effort, regardless of the number of competitors participating therein, held within the jurisdiction of the Municipality of Pavia. This includes team sports, racket sports, combat sports but excludes card games and board games.

PUBLIC EVENTS – any activity conducted participated in by a number of people held within the territorial jurisdiction of Pavia with the likelihood of the occurrence of accident or medical emergency/ies (rallies, campaign sorties, concerts, festivals, etc.) Funeral processions are excluded but must be properly coordinated with the Pavia Traffic Management Office.

SECTION 3. REQUIREMENT. All organizers of any sports tournament or event held within the Municipality of Pavia, Iloilo shall be required to provide Emergency Medical Services (EMS) to players during the duration of the said sports tournament or event at their expense. A formal request shall be made to the Mayor's Office thru the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO).

Furthermore, a reasonable fee shall be paid by the organizer to the Municipal Treasurer's Office in accordance with the Chapter IV, Provision 4.Q.01 (c) of the 2018 Municipal Revenue Code of Pavia, Iloilo.

A receipt duly issued by the Municipal Treasurer's Office shall be presented to the MDRRMO at least a day prior to the start of the sports tournament/event so that MDRRMO can properly deploy its personnel.

SECTION 4. EXEMPTIONS FROM PAYMENT. Sports Tournaments/Events organized by the Local Government of Pavia or in partnership with the Municipality of Pavia shall be exempted from payment of the fee stipulated in Section 3 of this Ordinance.

In the event that the said activity is held in partnership with the Municipal Government of Pavia, a certification shall be issued by the Office of the Mayor.

In case the school, business, organizer have their own Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Team, they are exempted from requisition and payment as long as the list is presented to the LGU prior to the event.

SECTION 5. PENALTY. Any organizer found violating the requirement/s imposed by this Ordinance shall be penalized as follows:

FIRST OFFENSE: Fine of One Thousand Pesos Php1,000.00

SECOND OFFENSE: Fine of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php1,500.00)

THIRD & FINAL OFFENSE: Fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php2,500.00). Organizer/s are banned from holding future events within the territorial jurisdiction of Pavia.

The Municipal Government may order the revocation of the license and/or permits procured by and/or issued to the organizers, as the case may be, if found to be liable.

SECTION 6. The Office of the Municipal Mayor together with the Local Youth Development Office (LYDO) and/or Tourism Office shall ensure that this Ordinance shall be in force and effect to ensure public order and safety especially during sports tournaments/events. The Office is enjoined to require Organizers to submit a contingency plan. It shall also provide advice and consultation, with the approval of

the Office of the Mayor, as necessary, for the effective implementation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7. Separability Clause. If any provision or part hereof is held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of the law or the provision not otherwise affected shall remain valid and subsisting.


SECTION 8. Repealing Clause. All ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof, which are consistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.

SECTION 9. Effectivity Clause. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and publication in a local newspaper of general circulation.


BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER, to furnish copies of this Ordinance to all concerned agencies and individuals for information and appropriate action.


