MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2023-25

ORDINANCE GIVING DUE RECOGNITION AND REWARD TO
PAVIANHONS AGED 70,80, 90, 100 YEARS OLD AND THE OLDEST
IN THE BARANGAY.

WHEREAS, Article XV, Section 4 of the Constitution mandates that it is the duty of the family to take care of its elderly members but the State may also design programs of social security for them;

WHEREAS, in addition to the abovementioned provision, Article XIII, section 11 of the Constitution also provides that the "State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development which shall endeavor to make essential goods, health and other social services available to

all people at affordable cost. There shall be priority for the needs of the underprivileged, sick, elderly, disabled, women and children";

WHEREAS, in consonance with the said Constitutional provisions, the Congress of the Philippines enacted Republic Act No. 7432, otherwise known as Senior Citizens Law to primarily protect the elder members of the society;

WHEREAS, also Article LIL, Section 458, Paragraph (5) (XVIL) of the Local Government Code provides that the Sangguniang Bayan shall approve ordinance which shall ensure the efficient and effective delivery of basic services and facilities and in addition shall, formulate policies and adopt measure mutually beneficial to the elderly and to the community, provide incentives for non-governmental agencies and entities and subject to the availability of funds, appropriate funds to support programs and projects for the benefit of the Senior Citizens;

WHEREAS, Senior Citizens belong to a special sector that needs singular attention to promote their social, economic and spiritual aspect of their lives, as well as allow them to convey their special concerns;

WHEREAS, a centenarian is a person who has attained the age of one hundred (100) years or more and such term is closely associated with longevity;

WHEREAS, there are many centenarians in the Municipality of Pavia but this fact is not formally recorded nor acknowledged officially. Considering that they are the living link to our history, appropriate recognition and reward should be accorded to them. This will form part of Pavia's effort to support senior citizens

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Title. This enactment shall be known as "An Ordinance giving due recognition and reward to Pavianhons aged 70, 80,90,100 years and the oldest in the Barangay".

SECTION 2. Before a centenarian can he recognized and given the reward, the following conditions shall be complied with:

Residents who are one hundred (100) years old as of December 31 of the current year must be registered at the Office of the Senior Citizens Affairs (OSCA) of Municipality of Pavia for proper identification and documentation.

The centenarian must show that they are bonafide residents of Pavia.

Upon presentment of proper and authentic documents, the Municipal government will grant each of the centenarian an amount of Twenty Five Thousand Pesos (P25,000.00) cash incentive.

SECTION 3. For Pavianhons aged 70 shall receive at least Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00), aged 80- Four Thousand Pesos (P4,000.00), aged 90 – Seven Thousand Pesos (P7,000.00), oldest in the Barangay Ten Thousand Pesos (P10,000.00)

SECTION 4. A certificate of recognition shall likewise be given to Pavianhon aged 90 years old, oldest in the barangay and the centenarian.

SECTION 5. Repealing Clause. All existing ordinances, resolutions, focal executive orders, and other rules and regulations which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and or modified accordingly.

SECTION 6. Separability Clause. Should any of these clauses or parts of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, all other remaining portions not so declared shall remain valid and effective.


SECTION 7. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after complying the requirements provided for in the Local Government Code.

BE IT ORDAINED FURTHER, to furnish copies of this Ordinance 2023-25 to all concerned for information and appropriate action.


